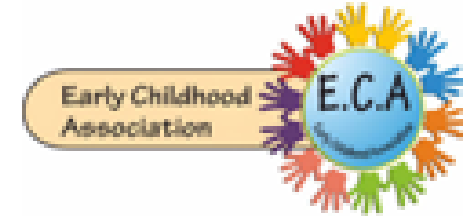

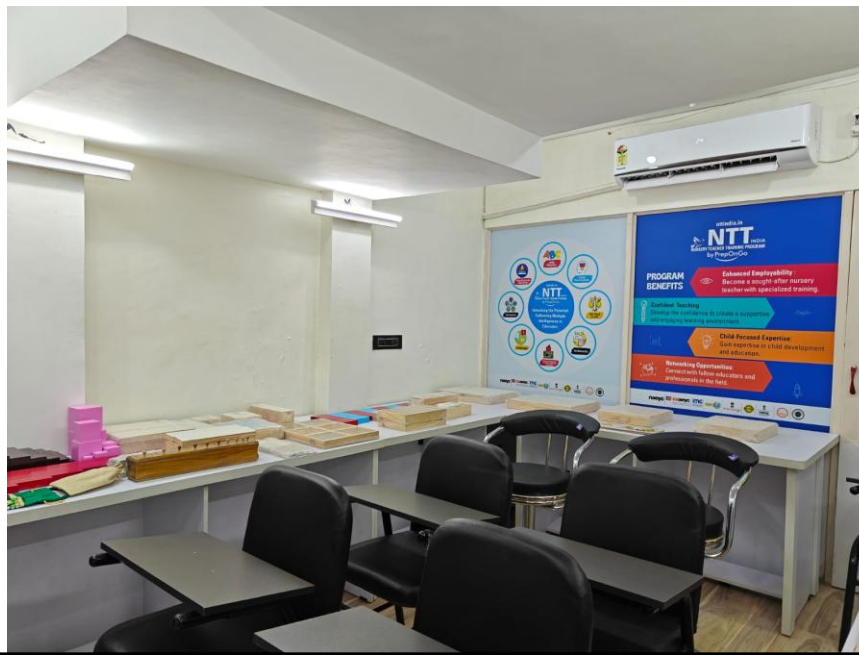

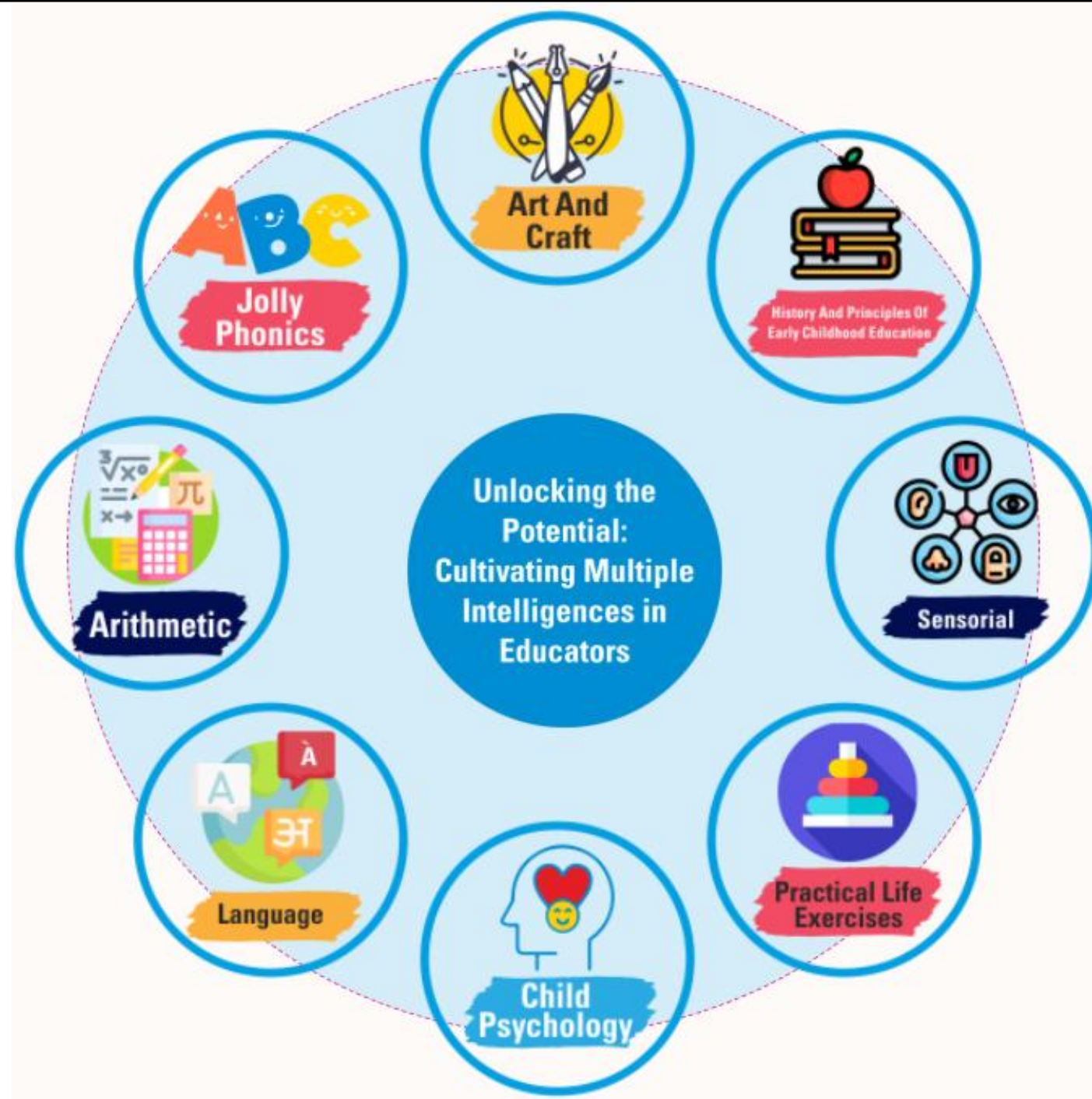

Curriculum

The course covers topics such as child development, early childhood education, curriculum planning, classroom management, child psychology, and teaching methods for young children.



Jolly Phonics

- Jolly Phonics is a systematic and multi-sensory approach to teaching phonics that has been proven to be highly effective in helping young children develop strong literacy skills. For pre-primary teachers, understanding and implementing Jolly Phonics can significantly enhance their teaching practices and improve student outcomes in reading and writing
- The 5 basic skills of Jolly Phonics covered are:
 - Learning the letter sounds
 - Learning letter formation
 - Blending
 - Identifying sounds in words (segmenting)
 - Tricky words

Some Key Reasons why Jolly Phonics?

- Building strong foundational literacy skills: Phonics instruction is essential for developing young children's ability to decode and encode words. Jolly Phonics provides a structured and sequential approach to teaching phonics, enabling teachers to systematically introduce **letter sounds, blending, and segmenting skills** that are crucial for reading and writing success.
- Engaging and interactive learning experiences: Jolly Phonics uses a multi-sensory approach that incorporates **actions, songs, and games** to make learning phonics fun and engaging for young children. Pre-primary teachers can use these multisensory activities to create dynamic and interactive lessons that cater to different learning styles and keep students motivated and focused.
- Promoting early literacy development: By teaching phonics using Jolly Phonics, pre-primary teachers can help children develop strong phonemic awareness skills, which are **foundational to reading and writing proficiency**. Phonemic awareness involves the **ability to hear, identify, and manipulate individual sounds in words**, and it plays a critical role in children's **literacy development**.

Topics covered in Arts & Crafts

Why Sensorial Education?

- **Development of Critical Skills:** Sensorial education helps children develop key sensory skills such as visual discrimination, tactile exploration, auditory discrimination, and olfactory recognition. These skills are essential for children to learn about their environment, make sense of information, and develop important cognitive abilities.
- **Stimulates Curiosity And Exploration:** Sensorial activities engage children's natural curiosity and encourage them to explore the world around them. By providing hands-on sensory experiences, teachers can promote active learning, creativity, and problem-solving skills in young learners.
- **Enhances Language And Communication Skills:** Sensorial experiences provide opportunities for children to use descriptive language and communicate their observations and experiences. This helps children develop vocabulary, language skills, and the ability to express themselves effectively.
- **Supports Holistic Development:** Sensorial education supports the holistic development of children, including physical, emotional, social, and cognitive development. By engaging children in sensory activities, teachers can help children develop their senses, fine motor skills, concentration, and emotional intelligence.
- **Fosters Appreciation For Diversity:** Sensorial education encourages children to appreciate and respect the diversity of sensory experiences and perspectives. By exploring different textures, tastes, smells, and sounds, children develop empathy, respect for others, and a greater understanding of the world around them.

Practical Life Exercises

The exercises of Practical Life have objects and materials normally encountered in everyday living experiences such as **cleaning, sweeping, pouring, dressing, plant and animal care**. The exercises of Practical Life fall into four major categories: **Care of the Self, Care of the Environment, Grace and Courtesy, and Control of Movement**. The basic Practical Life exercises include, but are not limited to the following:

- Hand washing
- Shoe polishing
- Using a napkin
- Packing and emptying a lunchbox
- Blowing one's nose
- Dressing frames to learn how to button, buckle, snap, tie bows, and lace shoes and many more.

Arithmetic

- Arithmetic is an essential subject for young children to develop their mathematical skills. In our nursery teacher training program, teachers will learn how to introduce basic arithmetic concepts to children in a **fun and engaging way**. Some of the key areas covered in the arithmetic curriculum include **counting, number recognition, simple addition and subtraction, and shape recognition**.
- Teachers will also learn the importance of **using concrete materials, such as blocks or counters**, to help children visualize and understand mathematical concepts. By incorporating **hands-on activities and games into their lessons**, teachers can make arithmetic more accessible and enjoyable for young learners.

Language

- Finally, language plays a crucial role in the overall development of children's literacy skills, including reading, writing, and vocabulary. **Pre-primary teachers can foster children's literacy skills by introducing them to a wide range of books, songs, rhymes, and word games that promote language development and literacy acquisition.**

Child Psychology

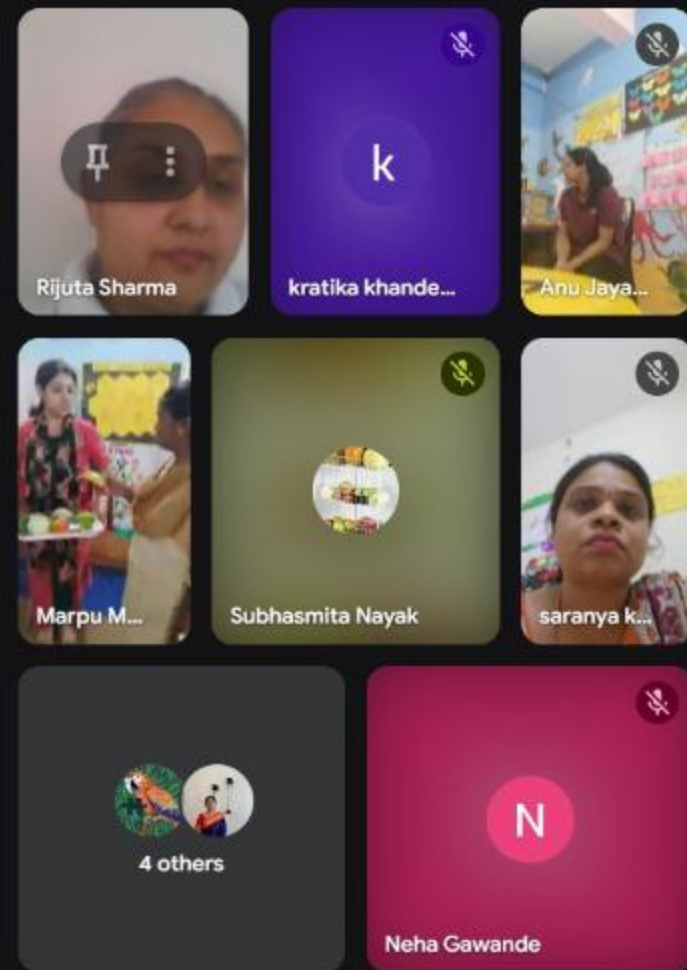
